If you worked in 2009 and earned less than \$49,000, then you may qualify. Our IRS certified volunteers will help you receive the maximum tax refund and help determine if you are eligible for the earned income tax credit.*

NEW this year, there will be a one-hour session at 2 PM for participants interested in learning more about how to navigate the college financial aid process. This class will provide tips to increase chances of securing financial aid for which participants are eligible. *Arrive for tax preparation services by 12 PM if you plan to attend this workshop.*

Please bring the following items:

- Photo ID
- Social Security cards or ITIN letters and birthdates for the taxpayer, spouse and all dependents
- Birth dates for taxpayer, spouse and dependents
- Wage and earnings statements: W-2, W-2G, and 1099 forms from all employers
- Unemployment compensation: Form 1099G
- Interest statements from bank and dividend statement from stock: Form 1099
- Day care expenses paid in 2009 and day care provider's name, address and federal ID number
- Record of tuition or student loan payments
- Copy of last year's federal and state returns
- Record of any Sales Tax paid on new vehicles purchased in 2009
- Record of any Real Estate Taxes paid in 2009
- Record of any Economic Recovery Payment received from SSA, RRB or VA in 2009
- Check or deposit slip if you want direct deposit

If filing electronically on a married filing joint return, both spouses must be present.
